What is Use Tax?

Sales tax imposed on the purchase of goods from online, out-of-state retailers only. (such as Amazon, Wayfair, etc.)

How much tax is proposed?

The use tax on out-of-state goods will be the same as purchases currently made at Oak Grove businesses. It is estimated to generate \$350,000 annually.

Will I be charged both taxes?

No, you will be charged one or the other.

Where will the revenue be used?

The city will use the revenue to improve and maintain the city streets.

Do other cities have this tax?

Yes, they do! More than 200+ cities including Grain Valley, Lees Summit, Sedalia and Clinton, locally.

When will I vote?

During the General Election on November 8th.
